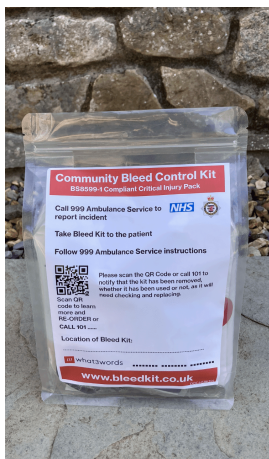
Definitely the most comprehensive and the Daniel Baird Foundation has been supplying bleed kits since 2017 and is definitely the most extensive on the market.

Designed by Ambulance Service for public use in 2017 - Have 15,000 - 20,000 across the country.

About to supply Westminster with 450 kits - has the largest number of bleed kits in the country.

There will be a requirement Listed Building Consent at the Church as it is Grade II listed which will can apply for or there is a stand alone unit above for a further £250 + VAT which clearly gets round the planning permission. £425 + VAT for bleed and cabinet
